TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

1. Add a new Denham Springs Historical District Streetscape Enhancement (262-03-0017) project under state ARRA projects in FY 2010 with \$300,000 ARRA and \$60,000 STPENH funds.
2. Add a new Northern Trailhead Enhancement (099-03-0012) project under state ARRA projects in FY 2010 with \$200,000 ARRA and \$30,000 STPENH funds.
3. Add a new I-12 Ramp Metering Equipment Procurement (737-99-1060) project under IM projects in FY 2010 with \$1.5 Million IM funds.
4. Add a new Central Thruway Paving (Florida Blvd to South End of Sullivan Bridge) (742-17-0165) project under ARRA projects in FY 2010 with \$960,993 ARRA and \$3,539,007 Local or STP>200K funds.
5. Increase in ARRA funds in FY 2010 for Project 077-03-0016 to overlay LA 73(US 61(N) - EBR Parish Line) from \$987,000 to \$1,853,567.
6. Increase in funds in FY 2010 for Project 050-07-0072 to overlay LA 1(ICWW - US 190) by adding ARRA Backup as a new funding source for \$1,713,000.
7. Increase in FBRON funds in FY 2010 for Project 260-01-0020 to bridge replacement of Amite River Relief Bridge from \$1,300,000 to \$2,616,000.
8. Increase in STP>200K funds in FY 2012 for Project 742-17-0118 to widen Sherwood Forest (Choctaw - Greenwell Springs Rd) to 5 lanes from \$9 Million to \$14.1 Million.

9. Increase in CMAQ funds in FY 2012 for Project 414-01-0036 to improve Nicholson Dr @ Brightside Lane intersection from \$1.5 Million to \$6.4 Million.

10. Add the following new Line Items to all the years in the TIP

- TSM Transportation Systems Management for \$350,000 using NHS funds
- TSM Transportation Systems Management for \$350,000 using STPFLEX funds
- Safe Routes to School for \$250,000 using STPHAZ funds
- ITS Intelligent Transportation System management for \$500,000 using ITS funds

11. Approve \$4,515,600 LADOTD Enhancement funds for the following projects: Northgate Pedestrian Corridor, Sacred Heart/CATS Area Pedestrian Improvements, Hyacinth Ave. Bike Lanes, Florida Blvd Corridor CATS Transit Passenger Shelters, Harding Blvd Corridor CATS Transit Passenger Shelters, Scotlandville Route CATS Transit Passenger Shelters, North Blvd. Town Square Project and Delmont Area Pedestrian Improvements. Approve LADOTD Enhancement funds for projects in Ascension, Livingston, and West Baton Rouge Parishes.

12. Approve \$400,000 LADOTD Bicycle/Pedestrian Education Grant for the MPO Region.
